

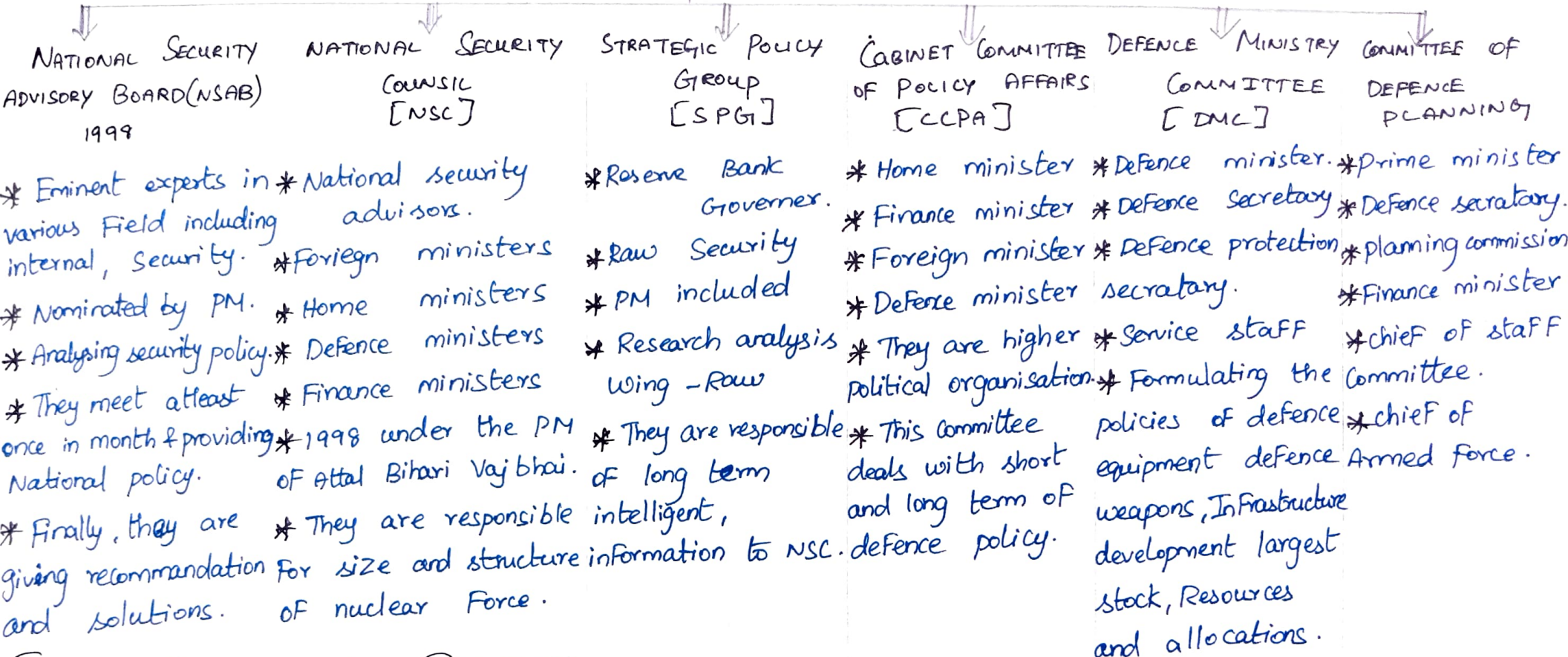

MOD \Rightarrow Ministry OF Defence

Role OF MOD.

The principal task of the defence Ministry is to obtain policy directions of the Governments on all defence and security related matters and communicate them for implementation to the services Headquarters, Inter services organisations, Production establishments and Research and Development organisations.

Functions OF MOD.

The Defence ministry is responsible for "obtaining policy directions of the Government on all defence and security related matters" and communicating these directions to "services Headquarters, Inter services organisations, Production Establishments and Research and Development Organisations."

The Department of Defence is responsible for providing the military forces needed to deter war and protect the security of our country.

Composition and Functions of Defence Committee.

- * To deal with all defence related issues.
- * To deal with issue relating to law and order and internal security.
- * To deal with policy matters concerning Foreign Affairs that have internal (or) external security implications including cases relating to agreements with other countries on security related issues.
- * To deal with economic and political issues impinging on national security.
- * To review the manpower requirements relating to national security including proposals concerning creation of posts carrying the pay scale (or) pay band plus Grade pay equivalent to that of a Joint secretary to the government of India and higher and sitting up new structures to deals with security related times.

④ * To consider all cases.

* Involving capital expenditure of more than rupees one thousand crore.

⇒ The Department of Defence Production.

⇒ The Department of Defence Research and development.

Chief of staff and Joint Service Organisation.

Chief of staff:

The chief of the army staff is the head of the military staff of the Indian Army and chairman of Indian Army Board. The chief is usually the highest ranking officer of the Indian Army unless the chief and vice chief of Defence are army officers.

Chief of Navy staff ⇒ Admiral Karam Bir Singh

5 Joint Service Organisation:

The Department of Military Affairs under the Chief of Defence Staff has the mandate for the "Facilitation of restructuring of Military Commands for optimal utilisation of resources by bringing about jointness operations including through establishment of joint / theatre commands. India's CDS Bipin Rawat has said that India will find its own way of constructing its unified commands.

Jointness and integration in the Indian military are varying degrees of synergy and cross-service. Co-operation between the military wings of Indian Armed Forces. Joint service organisations such as the integrated Defence Staff.
