

- MRS. HARDCASTLE TELLS HER THAT JEWELS ARE NOW OUT OF FASHION AND THAT SHE CAN DO WELL WITH HER NATURAL BEAUTY WITHOUT JEWELS.

- IT STRIKES MARLOW THAT HE HAS MADE A MISTAKE

- SIR CHARLES ASKS HER HOW HIS SON BEHAVED
