5. Fund mobilization and audit of NGO expenditures

Meaning of mobilization

It's the process of forming crowds, groups, associations and organisation for the pursuit of collective goals.

FUND :- Literally means sum of money which some enterprise is funded or expense supported

MOBILIZE/RAISE:- Bring about or to get

Sources of funds:-

The major type of support extended by the government to the voluntary agencies is in the form of grants-in-aids

Grants-in-Aids:-

It's some of money assigned by the higher to a lower authority either out of the former exchanger or out

of the revenue source specially designed for the purpose.

Eg, subsidy, concession, material incentive, staff deputation

#### AUDIT OF NGOS

The NGO must get its accounts audited as per the Incorporation law depending on their mode of form

of registration. NGO audit must be done as per the societies Act, Trust Act, or companies Act 2013, also

must be done as per the Income tax Act 1961.
