Out line of the term paper: Introduction, (what is the issue or problem)  
Literature review: significance of the problem, How do you plan to deal with the problem, what is your solution should be explained.

Main body: has two sections, sub divisions, points, and sub items should be given. Conclusion: In this, summarizes the results obtained in the process of work.

### **TERM PAPER PROCESS:**

- (1) Select your topic.
- (2) Research your topic thoroughly.
- (3) Prepare your term paper out line.
- (4) Write your proposal sample.
- (5) Write your paper.
- (6) Prepare your cover page.
- (7) Edit and proof read the final copy.

**DISCUSSION:** The purpose of discussion is to interpret and describe the significance of findings. What was already known about the research problem being investigated. Discussion will always connect to the introduction by way of research questions or hypotheses researcher

posed and the literature reviewed. Discussion should always explain how researchers study has moved the readers understanding of research problem.

**PRESENTATION** : The presentation is a group project. The presentation should include: a short introduction, hypothesis, a brief description of the methods, tables or graphs related to findings, and interpretation of data.
